1.Position (1). Vocational skills instructor in carpentry and joinery.

- Producing and marketing products made by host organization in cooperation with other staff
- Will be involved in entrepreneurship training through a practical approach to income generating activities.
- Will be involved in planning and administration in cooperation with other staff at the host organization.

Education:

Diploma in Civil Engineering after obtaining a certificate in crafts in carpentry 1 & 2 from any recognized institution

2.Position (1). Vocational skills instructor in tailoring.

Main Tasks /responsibilities:

- Will train, monitor and evaluate students in tailoring.
- Will work to improve quality of vocational skills training education.
- Producing and marketing products made by host organization in cooperation with other staff.
- Will be involved in entrepreneurship training through a practical approach to income generating activities
- Will be involved in planning and administration in cooperation with other staff at host organization.

Education:

Diploma in tailoring after obtaining a certificate in crafts 1 & 2 from any recognized institution

3.Position (1). School environmental coordinator.

- will be a part of the open school team that works for the student's common health, mainly through arranging social activities.
- Will help to improve the student's wellbeing at school.
- Will bring English language into our daily life at the school, thus strengthening English as a subject.

- Be a co-worker to our staff and raise the awareness of international cooperation.
- Will be a part of international events at the school and to raise the awareness of international cooperation.

Education. Bachelors degree in any of the following discipline courses from any recognized institution.

- i. Social work and social administration.
- ii. Business administration
- iii. Arts in social sciences.

4. Position (1) Assistant teacher

- Will be assistant teacher in at least one of the following subjects, music, dance, drama, sports (1)
- Will be assistant teacher in other subjects based on the applicant's qualifications.
- Will be support person/ community worker for some of the students.
- Will bring English into the daily life at the school.
- Will be a part of international events at the school and to raise the awareness of international cooperation.

Education: Minimum qualification is diploma in music dance and drama from any recognized institution.

Added advantage: for numbers 3 and 4, a credit in English is a strong added advantage. For number 4, any qualification in sports science is an added advantage.

- Citizens of Uganda
- Good communications skills and fluent in English.
- Able to work under minimum supervision
- Must be result oriented
- Able to work outside Uganda for a period of 1 year.
